
Parking is available on-site for 150 DKK per day or 25 DKK hourly. There are also 2 electric car charging stations.

Common Europe Advisory Council (CEAC)

COMMON Europe Advisory Council (CEAC) is a technical advisory council consisting of a representative sample of end user members from multiple Common Europe organizations. It is used as a forum for dialogue with IBM on strategic and long-term issues.

Through CEAC, Common Europe members have a direct link to IBM and the ability to get their voice heard with regards to new requirements and needs for the IBM i platform. They also receive an advanced insight into the future direction of the platform and learn about new functions, technologies and directions for the platform before they are publicly announced.

MEMBERS

CEAC members are IT experts with extensive IBM i experience, visionary ideas and business knowledge from a wide range of industry sectors. Their main task is to give IBM open, honest and constructive feedback on

strategic directions, feature sets, current shortfalls and potential new requirements for the IBM i platform. All members of CEAC must sign a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) with IBM to receive strategic information from IBM, and open answers & discussions regarding requirements. Any member that repeatedly fails to attend face-to-face meetings or monthly conference calls may be released from membership.

ORGANISATION

CEAC is a part of COMMON Europe (CE) and has a liaison to maintain communication with the COMMON Europe Board of Directors. Membership in CEAC is on voluntary basis and, as such, members do not get paid.

IBM LIAISON

IBM has a dedicated Program Manager assigned as a liaison to the CEAC. Her/His role is to plan, facilitate and host the monthly CEAC calls and face-to-face meetings. During meetings, they additionally have the role to

capture any actions and updates involving IBM, make sure IBM is responding to Requests For Enhancements in a proper and timely fashion, and that the right individuals from IBM are asked to attend monthly and face-to-face meetings when necessary. CEAC members may contact the IBM liaison directly between meetings if they have questions for IBM or need to follow up on a specific Request For Enhancements.

Copenhagen's Favorite Tourist Attractions

Copenhagen has many and varied tourist attractions for you to explore. Check out www.visit-copenhagen.com for more great ideas. Here are our 10 suggestions:

Tivoli Gardens

Opened in 1843 in Copenhagen, Tivoli Gardens is one of Europe's most famous—and one of the world's oldest operating—amusement parks, and served as a model for Disneyland in the United States. Tivoli offers a lively mix of attractions, gardens, and restaurants, and maintains a traditional feel and quaint charm.

Copenhagen Zoo

Get familiar with the iconic giant pandas while dining in the state of the art Panda House. Experience unforgettable close encounters with polar bears and see the world from a giraffe's perspective.

The Little Mermaid

One of Denmark's most beloved icons, the Little Mermaid first appeared in Hans Christian Andersen's famous fairy tale and achieved even wider recognition with Disney's 1989 animated adaptation. A statue of the character by artist Edvard Eriksen looks out over Copenhagen's harbor, and is among the city's most popular tourist attractions.

Amalienborg Palace

Amalienborg Palace is the official residence of the Danish royal family, the world's oldest monarchy. One of Copenhagen's most beautiful monuments and a popular visitor attraction, the Amalienborg complex contains four stately palaces: Christian VII's Palace, Frederik VIII's Palace, Christian IX's Palace, and Christian VIII's Palace.

Nyhavn

Copenhagen's waterfront Nyhavn district is one of the city's most picturesque destinations, featuring a canal lined with brightly painted townhouses and cozy bars, restaurants, and cafés. Cobble streets, sailboats, and tidy houseboats create a feeling of old-world charm that attracts visitors year round.

Rosenborg Castle (Rosenborg Slot)

Copenhagen's Rosenborg Castle is a Danish palace built in the early 17th century in the Dutch Renaissance style—typical of Danish buildings of the time—by architectural innovator King Christian IV. Originally the king's summer home, today the castle contains a museum exhibiting the Royal Collections, impressive heirlooms representing the span of royal Danish culture from the late 16th to 19th centuries.

Round Tower (Rundetårn)

The Round Tower is perhaps the best place in Copenhagen to enjoy panoramic views of the city's skyline with its fairytale old town and many spires. The observation deck is located 35 meters (115 feet) above street

level, offering an expansive view of inner Copenhagen. The tower was built by King Christian IV, the famous architectural innovator of Denmark, to be an astronomical observatory.

National Museum of Denmark

The National Museum of Denmark is the country's largest cultural and historical museum. Exhibits encompass 14,000 years of Danish history and include a prehistoric Sun Chariot, Egyptian mummies, and an original hash stall derived from Copenhagen's infamous commune, Christiania.

Experimentarium

The Experimentarium re-opened in 2017 after a complete makeover. The science centre truly is a celebration of curiosity, dedicated to playful science and offering hours of fun for the entire family.

Torvehallerne Market

This incredible market is jam-packed with more than 60 vendors selling everything from fresh fish to organic produce to home-baked goods. For travellers looking to eat their way through the city, this is the place to do it!

The 2 November is party night as we let our hair down in style in Tivoli entertainment's Axelborg.



Buses will return to the hotel at 22:30 but the night owls can party on in the town center and sample Copenhagen's exuberant nightlife.


