

## **Common Europe**

## Advisory Council (CEAC)

# COMMON Europe Advisory Council (CEAC) is a technical advisory council consisting of a representative sample of end user members from multiple Common Europe organizations. It is used as a forum for dialogue with IBM on

strategic and long-term issues.

Through CEAC, Common Europe members have a direct link to IBM and the ability to get their voice heard with regards to new requirements and needs for the IBM i platform. They also receive an advanced insight into the future direction of the platform and learn about new functions, technologies and directions for the platform before they are publicly announced.

#### **MEMBERS**

**CEAC members** are IT experts with extensive IBM i experience, visionary ideas and business knowledge from a wide range of industry sectors. Their main task is to give IBM open, honest and constructive feedback on strategic

directions, feature sets, current shortfalls and potential new requirements for the IBM i platform. All members of CEAC must sign a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) with IBM to receive strategic information from IBM, and open answers & discussions regarding requirements. Any member that repeatedly fails to attend face-to-face meetings or monthly conference calls may be released from membership.

# ORGANISATION CEAC is a part of Common Europe (CE) and has a liaison to maintain communication with the COMMON Europe Board of Directors. Membership in CEAC is on voluntary basis and, as such, members do not get paid.

# IBM LIAISON IBM has a dedicated Program Manager assigned as a liaison to the CEAC. Her/His role is to plan, facilitate and host the monthly CEAC calls and face-to-face meetings. During meetings, they addi-

tionally have the role to capture any actions and updates involving IBM, make sure IBM is responding to Requests For Enhancements in a proper and timely fashion, and that the right individuals from IBM are asked to attend monthly and face-to-face meetings when necessary. CEAC members may contact the IBM liaison directly between meetings if they have questions for IBM or need to follow up on a specific Request For Enhancements.



Olga Miralles

For services to the community

Olga Miralles is Technical Support at Software Greenhouse and Vice president of Common Iberia. Born in Barcelona she works as a freelance translator and has worked in the IT sector as an analyser, project manager and communications manager.

In 1999 she was resident in IBM's ITSO and is co-author of two IBM Redbooks -AS/400 System Handbook and AS/400 System Builder. Olga served as President of Common Spain for eight years until 2010, served on the Common Europe Advisory Council (CEAC) from 1993-1995 and again for four years from 2005 and was President of Common Europe thereafter from 2005-2009.

**Colin Spofford** 

For services to Common Europe and the community i-UG (UK)

Born in Leeds UK, after an early career as a Structural Engineer, Colin retrained as a programmer, developing and implementing systems on: IBM S/23, S34, S/36. He was fortunate enough to be present at the UK launch of the original AS/400 in June 1988.

In 1989 he setup his own software house, Springstone Software Services which became one of the leading UK providers of IT training on IBM i (and its predecessors). In 1993 he became a founding member of the National AS/400 User Group - NASUG.

He sold Springstone in 2003 and in 2007 decided to move away from the commercial side of the IT industry to concentrate on growing his property development business. He has continued working with the UK user group which has now morphed into i-UG, the largest active user group for IBM i in the UK and for the last 15 years he has been the i-UG Treasurer.

In 2010 i-UG he became the UK representative of Common Europe (2010-2021) and for three held the post of Treasurer.

Colin has been the backbone of the i-UG/Common UK for three decades and his dedication, perseverance and hard work is the reason why the i-UG is the largest IBM i user group in the UK, one of the largest in Europe and still growing to this very day.

## Discovering Gothenburg

#### **Liseberg Amusement Park**

Liseberg amusement park is one of Sweden's most visited tourist attractions and in 2023, the park won the award as Europe's best amusement park. The park features some world-class thrill rides, a beautiful garden and several popular restaurants. There is plenty to discover in the event district around Liseberg and many of Gothenburg's popular family hotels are located here.



#### **Haga District**

Haga is one of Gothenburg's oldest districts dating back to the mid-17th century, with cobblestone streets and traditional county governor's houses. This charming neighbourhood has a wonderful selection of cafés and small artisan shops. Did you know that you can find what is perhaps the world's largest cinnamon bun on the main street, Haga Nygata?

#### Universeum



#### Sweden's National Science Center,

houses an entire rainforest, an aquarium hall with exotic fish and sharks, lots of exotic animals and plants – all under one roof. The centre also shows exciting exhibitions and incredible 3D films at Sweden's largest visualization dome Wisdome.

### The Gothenburg archipelago

A string of islands in the sea outside Gothenburg. The islands in the southern part of the archipelago - such as Brännö, Styrsö and Vrångö – are car-free and can be reached by boat from Saltholmen. The northern islands Hönö, Öckerö and Björkö can be reached by car ferry from Lilla Varholmen. In the archipelago you can stroll through picturesque fishing villages, take a salty swim from the characteristic granite cliffs and hike along beautiful walking paths. It takes about an hour to get to the archipelago from central Gothenburg and a simple public transport ticket is enough for the journey.





#### The Gothenburg Museum of Art

If Art is more your style the museum has three stars in the Michelin Green Guide and impressive Nordic collections from the 15th century onwards. There are major exhibitions all year round and a large programme of guided tours and activities for children and young people.

Alternatively why not get a hands on experience in <u>Aeroseum</u>.

Or explore some Natural history: Göteborgs Naturhistoriska museum - Public\_GNM

#### Gothenburg Botanical Gardens is

one of the largest in Northern Europe. The cultivated part occupies 20 acres and holds about 20 000 different plants and trees. It is a botanical garden with a strong emphasis on horticulture and the garden is divided into different sections linked by lawns with fine trees and shrubs. You will find a kitchen garden, a herb garden,

perennial and annual borders, a Japanese glade, a rhododendron valley and a stunning rock garden with a waterfall. In the bulb garden you find species that are not grown anywhere else. The Greenhouses are closed and new ones will be built. The garden is bordering a nature reserve where also the arboretum is located.



Fish and shellfish is a real speciality in the port city of Gothenburg. Shrimp sandwiches, newly caught fish in classic and modern dishes, clams and oysters – the selection is huge! The iconic seafood market hall Feskekörka is a must for fish and seafood lovers.

Gothenburg is one of Europe's hottest hubs for craft beer and several of the city's breweries are among the best in the world. Check out the craft breweries that have popped up around town and try some of the local brews. Tap. Rooms in Gothenburg

#### **World of Volvo**

And when in Sweden...visit The World of Volvo. World of Volvo is an automotive museum and experience centre in Gothenburg, Sweden, jointly owned by Volvo Cars and Volvo Group. Opened in April 2024, it serves as a cultural and exhibition space for Volvo's brand and heritage.
